Information on recycling and take-back of electrical and electronic products

Dear Customers.

Electrical and electronic products (EEE products) can result in negative impacts on the environment and human health if not disposed of properly. Therefore, such products must be collected separately at the end of their life cycle and disposed of in a special way. This is indicated by the crossed-out wheeled garbage bin symbol in accordance with the EU WEEE Directive.

Like electrical and electronic products, the substances contained in batteries and luminaires (lamps) can have a negative impact on the environment and human health if not disposed of properly. In the case of products, which are capable of storing personal data, it is your responsibility to delete these before sending the products for recycling.

Bürkert Werke GmbH & Co. KG is aware that the preservation of an unpolluted environment is essential for a healthy life and sustainable growth for future generations. As a manufacturer of electrical and electronic products, Bürkert is subject to the requirements of the EU Directive 2012/19/EU (WEEE Directive) on waste electrical and electronic equipment, among others. This directive regulates the placing on the market and the return of electronic products. It is important to us to comply with this legal obligation in order to promote the take-back of WEEE and thus protect the environment.

We cooperate with a service company that supports us in complying with the requirements of the EU directive and its country-specific implementations. This cooperation enables us to provide our customers with a Europe-wide network of takeback systems that collect WEEE and recycle it properly.
